Dear Scholarship Applicant:

The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Commemoration Society, Inc. (MLK) for the past 21 years has awarded scholarships to our high school seniors. For 2024, MLK will award the following scholarships:

- 1. \$3,500 Servant Leader
- 2. \$2,500 Change Maker
- 3. \$1,500 Mountain of Hope
- 4. \$1,500 Drum Major for Justice
- 5. \$1,000 Beloved Community (3 scholarships)

The application deadline is Friday, May 17, 2024. Scholarship recipients will be notified by June 1, 2024. Scholarships will be distributed upon receipt after validation of enrollment in a postsecondary education institution. Deadline for post-secondary education institution enrollment is August 1, 2024, or the scholarship will be forfeited.

Applications will be considered and judged by an independent panel and final selections will be made by the MLK Commemoration Society Board of Directors based on the following criteria:

- Academic Achievement (transcript/grade point average)
- Leadership & Accomplishments (extra-curricular activities, honors and awards)
- Work/volunteer experience
- Community Involvement
- An essay (minimum 350 to 750 words maximum) in answer to the question provided (see application for details)
